

Rival NCP factions join hands against BJP in Chandgad tehsil of Kolhapur

Kolhapur, Nov 11 (UNI) : In a strange political development, the rival factions of Nationalist Congress Party-Sharad Pawar and Ajit Pawar have decided to form alliance for local body election in Chandgad tehsil of this district, which is likely to change political equations in the state in the backdrop of upcoming elections.

State minister and senior NCP (AP) leader from the district Hasan Mushrif announced this decision today and said this equation will become first in the state.

As per the agreement, both NCP factions have formed a front, called 'Rajesh Shahu Vikas Aghadi', to contest Nagar Panchayat and ZP elections in Chandgad against BJP led by Chandgad MLA Shivaji Patil.

Mushrif said that he took this decision following discussion with Dr Nandatai Babhulkar (NCP-SP) and former MLA Rajesh Patil (NCP-SP).

He explained that they took the decision of alliance with NCP(SP) as BJP is not keen on having an alliance with them in the Chandgad tehsil, so they decided to enter into alliance with NCP-SP to contest against BJP in the tehsil. Meanwhile, MLA Shivaji Patil reacted that the alliance between two factions of NCP was 'natural'. A few days ago, a local leader of the Sharad Pawar faction of NCP had hinted that both NCP factions could join forces.

Customs seize narcotics and gold

Mumbai, Nov 11 (UNI) : Customs officials at Mumbai's Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport have seized narcotics and gold valued at approximately Rs 14 crore during a series of anti-smuggling operations conducted over three days.

Authorities confirmed on Tuesday that the seizures were made in five separate cases, and detailed investigations are underway to identify the individuals and networks involved.

According to officials, the operation was part of a

focused surveillance drive aimed at curbing the smuggling of contraband into India.

In the first case, customs officers detained a passenger arriving from Bangkok after observing suspicious behaviour. A search of the traveller's baggage led to the discovery of 2.87 kilograms of narcotic substances, estimated to be worth 72.87 crore.

On the following day, two additional passengers arriving from Phuket were apprehended. Inspection of their belongings

revealed approximately four kilograms of narcotics, valued at around 4.2 crore.

During the final day of the operation, customs personnel intercepted two more passengers travelling from Bangkok and Nairobi.

Upon examination, officials recovered a d d d d d quantities of prohibited drugs as well as 22-carat gold bars weighing 358 grams, valued at roughly 3.7 lakh.

In total, the three-day enforcement drive resulted in the recovery of narcotics and gold worth nearly Rs 14 crore.

Anjali Damania to make revelations of parth Pawar Land Case

Mumba Nov 11 (UNI) : After meeting with Maharashtra Revenue Minister Chandrashekar Bawankule, social activist Anjali Damania said here on Tuesday that she will conduct a press conference on Wednesday to make further disclosures regarding the Mundhwa land scam case of Parth Pawar, the son of Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar.

Damania also demanded that Ajit Pawar resign from his posts as Guardian Minister and Deputy Chief Minister. She said that she has submitted all related documents to Revenue Minister Bawankule and will be making a major revelation about them tomorrow.

Before that, however, Damania also criticized Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis today. "I had a meeting with the Revenue Minister. I have to present everything before the committee and provide the information to Committee Chairman Vikas Kharge. I want to explain how these land mafias carry out their scams. I showed Minister Bawankule the papers from the Galkwad family of Pune-including a 1932 certificate related to the Mahar Watan land," she said.

"When the land was handed over to the government, they did not accept compensation, and I have provided evidence of this. I also gave him copies of the letters, she said.

The government will hold a hearing with the Galkwad family to decide whether to return the land to them," Damania added.

"The government issued a notice cancelling the deal by paying Rs 42 crore, but that notice is wrong. The Revenue Department has not conducted an inquiry into this matter - it must go through the court. I will provide some of the evidence tomorrow," she stressed.

2 Young siblings drown after falling into canal

Nanded, Nov 11 (UNI) A heart-wrenching tragedy has struck Neemgaon village in the Ardhapur administrative division of Nanded district, where two small children from the same extended family drowned after accidentally slipping into a canal near their home. The devastating incident has plunged the local community into profound grief and mourning.

An official said on Tuesday that the deceased have been identified as Sharwani Vitthal Chavan Rathod (2½). According to police reports, both children had accompanied their families to visit their grandmother's residence in Neemgaon. Sharwani's mother, a resident of Belkhed locality in Ayuthaya district, had travelled to Neemgaon with her daughter to spend time with her family. The tragic event occurred while the two children were playing in an open area close to their grandmother's house, where water had accumulated in a nearby irrigation canal. During play, both youngsters reportedly lost their footing and fell into the deep water. When
