Shinde vows action against illegal Bangladeshi; verification of papers planned

Mumbai, Feb 13 (UNI) Deputy Chief Minister Eknath Shinde on Friday announced that the state government would initiate strict measures against illegal Bangladeshi immigrants residing in Mumbai. He said Aadhaar cards and other government documents allegedly obtained fraudulently would be verified.

Stating that the city must be made "Bangladeshi-free", Shinde said investigations would be conducted wherever such individuals are found and necessary action would be taken, including deportation.

His remarks came shortly after newly elected Mumbai Mayor Ritu Tawde declared that action against illegal Bangladeshi and Rohingya hawkers would be a key priority during her tenure. She had said a joint meeting with police and civic officials would be convened to identify and remove hawkers allegedly encroaching on city roads.

The statements drew criticism from AIMIM leader Waris Pathan, who accused the ruling party and civic leadership of focusing on divisive rhetoric instead of addressing pressing civic concerns. He said there was no data on the number of alleged infiltrators detained or arrested, stressing that issues such as air pollution, infrastructure and quality of life required urgent attention.

Ritu Tawde was elected unopposed as Mayor of the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation earlier this week, ending the Shiv Sena's 25-year control over the civic body and returning the BJP to the top municipal post after 44 years.

Shinde Sena corporator Sanjay Ghadi was also elected Deputy Mayor unopposed.

Shiv Sena (Uddhav Balasaheb Thackeray) to Act Against Corporators Who Backed Bharatiya Janata Party in Chandrapur: Sanjay Raut

Mumbai, Feb 13 (UNI) Shiv Sena (UBT) MP Sanjay Raut on Friday asserted that disciplinary action will be taken against corporators and office-bearers who supported the BJP candidate instead of the Congress in the Chandrapur mayoral election.

In the Chandrapur mayoral polls, local leaders from the Thackeray faction decided at the last moment to support the BJP, claiming they were insulted by local Congress office-bearers despite being in constant touch with them. As a result, BJP's Sangeeta Khandekar was elected Mayor, while Shiv Sena (UBT)'s Prashant Danve was elected Deputy Mayor.

The BJP has also reportedly offered the Standing Committee chairperson's post to the Thackeray faction.

Talking to mediapersons here, Raut clarified that the decision to align with the BJP in Chandrapur was taken at the local level and did not have the approval of the party leadership. He warned that if the move was driven by personal interests, strict action would follow.

Meanwhile, Maharashtra Navnirman Sena leader Sandeep

Deshpande alleged that Shiv Sena (UBT) corporators were paid ₹1 crore each to support the BJP in Chandrapur. Raut dismissed the allegation sarcastically, questioning whether those making the claims were present to count the cash and whether they received a 20 percent commission in the deal.

Raut thanked the Indian National Congress for supporting Shiv Sena (UBT) in the Parbhani mayoral election. He strongly defended the appointment of Syed Iqbal as Mayor, stating that he is a committed Shiv Sainik who has worked for the party for years and has served as a taluka chief.

Raut emphasized that religion should not be a factor in questioning Iqbal's appointment. He pointed out that India is a democracy and recalled that the BJP had supported eminent scientist A. P. J. Abdul Kalam as President of India.

He noted that several Muslim leaders have served as Governors, Chief Justices, and in other high constitutional posts, and therefore there is no reason to doubt Iqbal's capability to function as Mayor of Parbhani.

Don't Interfere in Our Internal Party Matters ; Hasan Mushrif Rebukes Rohit Pawar

Mumbai, Feb 13 (UNI) Senior leader of the Nationalist Congress Party (Ajit Pawar faction) and state minister Hasan Mushrif on Friday pulled up NCP (Sharad Pawar group) MLA Rohit Pawar, advising him not to interfere in the internal affairs of his party.

Talking to reporters, Mushrif stated that the late Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar was Rohit Pawar's uncle, and therefore it is understandable if Rohit expresses doubts about the plane crash and seeks clarification. However, he emphasized that Rohit Pawar should refrain from meddling in the internal matters of another party.

While raising questions about the crash, Rohit Pawar in statements to the media, had also commented

on the possible merger of the two NCP factions and other related issues.

Responding to this, Mushrif said that Praful Patel and Sunil Tatkare are senior leaders of their party. Patel serves as the National Working President, while Tatkare is the Maharashtra State President. Both have made significant contributions to the party, and questioning their integrity now is unwarranted, he remarked.

On the issue of merger, Mushrif said he has spoken about it several times in the past. Discussions were reportedly initiated by Ajit Pawar, though no other NCP leaders were directly involved. However, he clarified that he has never claimed that such discussions did not take place. Given the changed

political circumstances after Ajit Pawar, Mushrif stated that the Bharatiya Janata Party would have to be taken into confidence regarding any future developments.

Rohit Pawar recently held press conferences in Mumbai and Delhi, raising several doubts regarding the cause of the plane crash and hinting at the possibility of sabotage.

Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis had earlier sought a thorough investigation into the crash from the union Civil Aviation Minister, saying that no doubts should remain regarding the incident. Mushrif noted that NCP (Ajit Pawar group leaders) too have voiced their concerns from time to time.

Congress slams Govt over Bishnoi Gang threats to Bollywood stars

Nagpur, Feb 13 (UNI) Congress on Friday intensified its attack on the Maharashtra government, alleging a sharp decline in law and order across the state, particularly in Mumbai, following fresh threats reportedly linked to the Lawrence Bishnoi gang against leading Bollywood personalities.

Addressing the media in Nagpur, Maharashtra Congress spokesperson Atul Londhe held the state administration responsible for what he described as a surge in criminal activities and growing insecurity.

He squarely blamed Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis, who also handles the home department, saying the responsibility for

maintaining public safety rests directly with him.

"The law-and-order situation is deteriorating not just in Mumbai but even in Nagpur, which is the Chief Minister's own city," Londhe said.

His remarks followed reports that actor Ranveer Singh received a threat message via WhatsApp earlier this week.

Around the same time, unidentified persons allegedly opened fire outside filmmaker Rohit Shetty's residence in Mumbai's Juhu locality, reportedly firing five rounds.

A person claiming to be associated with gangster Lawrence Bishnoi later took responsibility for the shooting, according to

Londhe. The Congress leader also referred to earlier threats targeting actor Salman Khan, including a firing incident outside his residence, calling them part of a pattern of repeated security failures under the current regime.

Drawing a comparison with the previous Congress-led government, Londhe asserted that organised crime and extortion rackets had been effectively curbed during that period.

(Contd from page 1) every Monday. However, preliminary information suggests that a few students consumed additional tablets the following day in the absence of teachers.

On Wednesday night, 19 students began experiencing symptoms such as nausea, dizziness and severe discomfort. The school administration promptly arranged for ambulances and the affected children were taken to Chandrapur District Hospital.

Doctors attending to the students stated that 16 of them are in stable condition, while three are being kept under observation as a precaution.

Zilla Parishad Chief Executive Officer Pulkit Singh has directed a high-level investigation into the matter to ascertain responsibility and prevent recurrence.

He termed the incident involving an alleged bribe in connection with the suspension of a medical store licence as "highly inappropriate" and assured that no one involved will be shielded

investigation. Speaking to reporters in Delhi, Zirwal said he has been in the national capital for the past three days and will convene a meeting upon returning to Mumbai to conduct a thorough inquiry into the matter.

He emphasized that strict action would be taken against anyone found guilty, without any favoritism.

The controversy erupted after a clerk from Zirwal's office was caught red-handed while allegedly accepting a bribe of ₹35,000 from the owner of a medical store in Latur, whose licence had been cancelled. The bribe was reportedly demanded in exchange for revoking the cancellation order. The clerk, along with another individual, has been taken into custody, and the office has been sealed as part of the
